



## SYNOPSIS

In Southern Portugal, 50 km far from Lisbon, there's a territory of rare natural beauty, set on one of the coastlines in Europe, with the least man made intervention. The set for a race almost unique in the world, running for 43 km on sandy beaches along side the Atlantic Ocean. A challenge that requires attitude, mental strength, preparation, training and sacrifice. The athletes challenge their own limits, confronting the distance and crossing for all of us, that territory. The truly impressive record of this race is 2h45m, run by Eusébio Rosa. But for the most of the athletes the challenge is just to reach the end. We followed eight of them, of different origins and conditions, talking about their motivations to run, about what they think while they run, and what being a runner means in their life.
